Rev. Albert Kimble was born in Lexington, Mississippi, on September 12, 1962, to Louis and Claudine B. Kimble Townsend. He departed this life on May 2, 2023, at Select Specialty Hospital in Memphis, Tennessee. He was a proud graduate of Southside High School, Class of 1981.

Albert confessed Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior as a young man. He joined Hopewell Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor James E. Pugh and was baptized. As he grew in the Lord, he accepted the call of God into the ministry and went on to attend Brewster Theological Clinic and School of Religion, founded by Dr. W. Herbert Brewster. Having honorably completed the course of study as prescribed by the faculty and board, Albert received his Bachelor of Theology on July 11, 1990.

He later joined New Sardis Baptist Church under the leadership of Dr. L. LaSimba M. Gray, Jr., where he served faithfully as an Associate Minister of the Gospel until his departure. Albert was recognized by the Golden Circle Ministry of New Sardis for his history-making Children's Hour, among other accomplishments.

He was currently an employee of Federal Express Corporation for 38 years. Albert loved his job and his colleagues in Aircraft Maintenance. He was the
