



Cedric Robinson

March 9, 1964 - January 22, 2021

Cedric Robinson was born March 9, 1964 at Tauberian Hospital in Mound Bayou, Mississippi. He was the second child of Clarence and Clara Robinson. He was raised in Drew, Mississippi, until age seven, when the family moved to Cleveland, Mississippi. He attended elementary school at St. Gabriel Catholic School, Mound Bayou, Mississippi, and was a 1982 graduate of East Side High School, Cleveland, Mississippi.

Cedric graduated from Alcorn State University, Lorman, Mississippi, with a bachelor's degree in biology. From there he worked as a correctional officer with the Mississippi State Department of Corrections in Parchman, Mississippi.

He later attended the University of Kansas, Lawrence, Kansas, where he earned a master's degree in healthcare administration. He was employed by the Texas Department of Corrections Prison Hospital and also worked for the U.S. Federal Prison in Schuylkill, Pennsylvania.

Deciding to move back south, he worked as an assistant manager at lifeblood blood services in Memphis, Tennessee. At the time of his passing, he was employed with the Shelby County Health Department.

Cedric was preceded in death by his grandparents, John & Amelia Robinson

and Arthur & Zelma Wilson, and his father, Clarence Robinson. He leaves loving memories to his mother, Clara Robinson, Cleveland, Mississippi; and his sisters, Kelet Robinson (Michio), Denver, Colorado, and Cheryl Robinson-Turner (Daniel), Beaumont, Texas. He was a favorite of his nieces, Niara Turner and Abigail Watanabe and nephew, Kobie Turner.

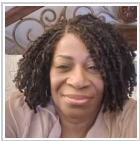
