



## James Marion

November 10, 1958 - March 10, 2022

We are gathered here today in memory of James Henry Roderick Marion, most affectionately known as “Bucky”. Bucky was a lover of music, family and football. Today, we will acknowledge and share both our joy in the gift that his life was to us and the pain that his passing brings. In sharing the joy and the pain together today, may we lessen the pain and remember more clearly the joy.

Bucky was just 63 years old when he passed away on Thursday, March 10, 2022, at the Veterans Hospital. He was born November 10, 1958, here in Memphis, Tennessee, to Henry Johnson and Julia M. Greer; he was the oldest of seven siblings.

Bucky was baptized at an early age at New Life Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor Howard.

Bucky enlisted in the United States Army on November 4, 1977, and served until 1983. Sgt. Marion received an honorable discharge and was also awarded the following: the Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbons, Sharp Shooter Badge (M-16), and the Good Conduct Medal. Sgt. Marion worked as a Tactical Communication System Specialist.

Bucky was employed with Memphis Jewish Home for twenty years. On

August 7, 1982, he married Ms. Dorothy Richardson while stationed at Ft. Carson, Colorado.

Bucky leaves to cherish his memories, his mother, Mrs. Julia M. Greer (John, deceased); two daughters, Jamie Griffin (Steve) and Jamille Wright; one son, Jamien Wright; two brothers, John Marion (Stephanie) and Gerald Greer; two sisters, Vicki Hall and Linda Greer Mitchell (Anthony); two uncles, Mr. Frank Moore (Elizabeth) and Mr. Alexander Boddie; his aunt, Ruth Smith; special friend, Ms. Freddie Miller; children in love, Shuntel Gwynn and Quinton Gwynn; and a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

He was preceded in death by his father, Henry Johnson; sister, Corliss Marion Wiggins; and his brother, Calvin Greer.
