



## Robert Lee Cage Sr.

July 11, 1939 - February 28, 2023

Robert Lee Cage, 83 years old, was born July 11, 1939, in Robinsonville (Lake Cormorant) Mississippi to the union of Ernest H. Cage, Sr. and Robie Lee Cage who both preceded him in death. He was the fourth child of 16 siblings, nine boys and seven girls.

Robert accepted Christ at a very young age at Beautiful Zion Baptist Church, in West Memphis, Arkansas. As a young man he always wanted to be like his father.

His father was a professional truck driver and he asked him to teach him how to drive trucks and without hesitation his father taught him with a smile on his face.

He was very proud. Robert Lee was fourteen years of age when he started driving trucks for a living; first with his father and later by himself all across the country. This was his greatest joy and he knew this would make him happy; he could make a living as a professional truck driver.

Robert was drafted into the United States Army Reserve and received an

honorable discharge in April 1969. He married Marie Jackson and to that union his first child was born, Stephanie Cage Sibley. He later married Sammie Lee Sanders and to that union, Robert Lee Cage, Jr. was born. He spent later years with Jeanette Reynolds and her sons Justin & Jason Reynolds.

Robert continued in his profession as a truck driver working for some of the best trucking companies in the state. He worked last for Consolidated Freightways Transport Company. He drove trucks for over 50 years until experiencing a truck malfunction while crossing the TN River Bridge that led him to retirement.
